Pool and Clubhouse Rules

Please take a few minutes to review the Providence Glen Pool & Clubhouse Rules.

1. Providence Glen Pool is for the use and enjoyment of its residents and their supervised guest. No guests are allowed in the pool or clubhouse without a resident present. Do not loan your pool access card out. Controlling access to the pool and clubhouse is a safety and health issue.
2. Residents are responsible for the actions of their guest. Damages will be charged to the resident. In the case of a tenant resident, the owner of the unit will be charged for the damages.
3. Entry to and use of the party room is by paid reservation only! Do not use this room to access the pool. Violators of this policy are subject to fines and revocation of pool and clubhouse privileges.
4. Glass of any kind is not allowed in the pool area. Glass in the pool area may cause the pool to be shut down by the Town of Chapel Hill Pool Inspections Department. If this happens, the pool will be closed for 5 to 7 days for cleaning and re-inspection.
5. The gas grills are for residents use. Please make sure you understand how to use the grill. Please make sure you turn it off after use.
6. Pool is closed after dark. This is for your safety.
7. Do not throw cigarette butts on the ground. Do not leave bagged trash at the pool area. Please do not swim alone at anytime. If you do go to the pool, let someone know you are going and when you expect to return to your unit.
8. Diving is not permitted. The pool is not of sufficient depth to dive safely.
9. Bathing suits must be worn in the pool. Cut-offs, street clothes and inappropriate swim wear are not allowed in the pool.
10. Any food or drink items taken into the pool or surrounding area must be removed by the individuals who brought them in. Place all trash in containers.

The pool and clubhouse are assets to your community. They are there for your enjoyment, so please take care of them. Excess maintenance of these facilities and damage to them cost all of you in increased HOA dues or higher rents. Please report all vandalism to our office at 919-883-3200 ext. 1543 or 919-282-7014.
